

In addition to the chalk and talk method of teaching, the faculty members use IT enabled learning tools such as PPT, Video Clips, Audio system to expose the students to advanced knowledge and practical learning. Classrooms with LCD/OHP/Computers support effective pedagogy. ICT enabled tools proved to be very effective during this pandemic.

Google Classroom

Google Classroom is a virtual classroom, enables effective teaching and learning with live sessions. It includes virtual meetings, slide shows, assignments, grade sheets and attendance, with a data storage facility. The discussion forum feature of the Google classroom helps in peer learning. Teachers conduct quizzes and tests with this application. It is accessible via Desktop / Laptop /and Android/iOS mobile applications.

Video Conferencing tools

The video conferencing tools like Microsoft teams, Zoom, Google Meet are used to conduct online classes / Meetings / Webinars / workshops with students.

Microsoft Teams has also been adopted by the College as a unified platform for online teaching, facilitating enriched teacher-student interactive interface.

Zoom Platform is also used to conduct meetings and Webinars at times. The ZOOM Video Webinar feature allows the teacher/host to interact with students/audience through an in-session chat option. It is also useful for moderating the discussion through its Q&A and Raise Hand feature. The teachers use the ZOOM platform extensively to present lectures in the Teaching Learning Centre (TLC). The ZOOM platform allows the session to be broadcasted LIVE over YouTube. The sessions can be recorded for later use.

Google Meet is used to host a video session/lecture. Teachers can invite upto 100 participants and record the sessions for later access. This is another widely used teaching-learning tool in addition to google-classroom in the campus.

Students can also use the mobile applications of all the above video conferencing tools for easy access on-the-go.
